then	I went to bed <b>then</b> .
men	Three <b>men</b> came to see me.
ten	She has <b>ten</b> cats.
open	She will <b>open</b> the box.
seven	I am <b>seven</b> years old.
women	Two <b>women</b> sat on a bench.
even	This chair is <b>even</b> bigger than the other one!
often	They went to the park <b>often</b> .
children	Six <b>children</b> played in the water.
